Academic Attire

Many of the academic traditions associated with higher education come to us from the Middle Ages. Among the traditions are the hierarchy of degrees as well as the colorful costume attire which originally served the practical purpose of keeping students and teachers warm. Modern academic costume in the United States is based on an intercollegiate code of uniformity but retains its traditional meaning and significance.

The gown is black with the cut of the garment denoting the degree earned. The bachelor gown is worn closed at the neck and has long pointed open sleeves; the master's gown has long open sleeves with the forearm coming through a slit near the elbow. The doctor's gown is paneled in velvet with three velvet chevrons on each full, bellow-shaped sleeve.

Many graduates of European universities wear gowns of the color of the universities from which they graduated.

The hood is the most important feature of the academic costume. Made of black material, it is lined with the colors of the college or university granting the degree and is edged and bound with velvet of the color denoting the degree. For instance, the hood of a Wisconsin graduate is lined with crimson velvet, a Minnesota graduate wears a hood lined with maroon and gold while a California graduate's hood is lined with blue and gold. Some of the colors used to bind and edge the hood are brown for Fine Arts, dark blue for Philosophy, golden yellow for Science, light blue for Education, copper for Economics and pink for Music. The bachelor's hood is rarely worn but has a two inch velvet border, the master's hood has a three inch border while the doctor's degree hood has a five inch border.

Mortarboards are standard for all degrees with the only variation being in the color of the tassel. Although a tassel is usually black, it may be colored to indicate the department of study or of metallic gold to denote the doctor's degree.
