



John Noel

John M. Noel was born and raised in Wausau, Wisconsin. He graduated from Newman Catholic High School and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in communication, public relations and advertising from the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point in 1971.

Following graduation, John spent the next 15 years with Sentry Insurance. In 1985 he left Sentry and purchased the rights to Travel Guard International which has become the leading travel insurance company in the United States. Travel Guard also serves as the cornerstone of Noel Group, a family of service, travel, insurance, and real estate businesses with 489 employees in 14 worldwide locations.

John and his wife, Patty, have dedicated their lives to improving the world around them. In 1993 the Noels established Make A Mark - a nonprofit humanitarian project that funds sustainable building projects for philanthropic purposes in developing countries. Through the years, Make A Mark has rebuilt a kindergarten in war-ravaged Klipi, Croatia; built and equipped a hospital addition in Rostov-Veliky, Russia; created a computer lab for low income students in Eleuthera, Bahamas; and built staff quarters for the Nyumbani Orphanage in Karen, Kenya. Recently Make A Mark partnered with the Nelson Mandela Children's Fund to create a self-sustaining community for orphans, elderly and disabled adults. Through Make A Mark, John and Patty are currently working on a shelter for homeless children in Brazil.

In 1996 John and Patty created The Noel Compass Scholar Program to encourage and reward academic achievement, leadership, and citizenship for high school students of color in Wisconsin schools. The program includes room, board and tuition at UWSP. It also provides the students with a paid internship at the Noel Group. With six children of their own and eight Compass scholars, the Noels have supported 14 students in college.

As part of their commitment to cultural diversity, John and Patty helped create a class at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point called "Ethnic Diversity in Wisconsin," and provided a grant so that portions of the class could be broadcast on area cable access channels. In 1999 John was named a distinguished alumnus at UWSP. Recently John and Patty Noel were presented with the Franklin Covey Humanitarian Service Award, given to "outstanding individuals who reach out to improve the quality of life for individuals, groups, or humankind."



Chancellor's Medallion and the UWSP Ceremonial Mace

The Chancellor's medallion and the UWSP ceremonial mace were both hand-crafted by former art professor Henry Runke. The medallion was cast in a 14K yellow gold pendant in 1968 and contains a purple amethyst to represent the school colors. The four sectioned areas terminating near the center symbolize the four colleges of the university and terminate as prongs for the gem. The mace, carried by the grand marshal of academic processions, was completed in 1976 and has a square base on which important dates in the school's history are recorded. The most prominent feature is the mace head which is a miniature of the cupola on Old Main, the school's symbol. The inside of the mace also includes a purple amethyst.






